

IMPROVEMENT OF THE SYSTEM OF EVACUATION OF PERSONS DEPRIVED OF LIBERTY IN SITUATIONS OF NATURAL AND SOCIAL THREATS.

SUMMARY

One of the formations responsible for internal security in Poland is the Prison Service, which is an armed and uniformed service. It carries out imprisonment, implements a preventive measure in the form of temporary detention as well as, implements punishments resulting in the restriction of freedom, co-creating the system of protection of society from offenders. The subject of the study is the processes, relationships and phenomena occurring in the Prison Service identified in the aspect of evacuation of persons deprived of liberty.

The purpose of the study was to develop a concept for improving the evacuation system for people deprived of liberty in situations of natural and social threats.

The main research problem is as follows: What threats affect on the functioning of the current system of evacuation of detainees in situations of natural and social threats, and what changes should be made to ensure the effectiveness of the system by modifying the existing procedures.

Referring to the presented research problem, the main hypothesis was formulated: The existing inadequacies of the current system of evacuation of inmates in situations of natural and social threats require the development and implementation of uniform standards to improve the efficiency of its operation, which translates directly into an increase in public safety and the safety of evacuation of inmates.

The work consists of seven chapters and also, an introduction and a conclusion.

The first chapter discusses methodological assumptions, including: the purpose of the research, the main problem, specific problems, hypotheses and variables. Research techniques and methods are presented and, the course of the research and the research sample are described.

The second chapter presents the legal conditions and organizational basis governing the Prison Service. Chapter Three presents the organizational structure and functioning of the Prison Service.

Chapter Four identifies persons deprived of their liberty in relation to imprisonment and their rights and obligations.

Chapter Five articulates evacuation as a determinant of security risks for inmates in emergency conditions.

Chapter Six characterizes emergency events in the practice of the Prison Service and evacuation operations in the context of the logistics of evacuation operations.

The seventh chapter formulates the concept and directions as well as, planes for improving the security of the evacuation system of detainees deprived of liberty in case of natural and social threats.
